

# Service Type

Service types define the guaranteed level of service in a [ATM](#) network. This involves such things as the timing between the source and destination, the guaranteed bandwidth and how many cells get lost in transmission.

Setting	Description
UBR without PCR	Use <a href="#">Unspecified Bit Rate</a> without <a href="#">Peak Cell Rate</a> .
UBR with PCR	Use <a href="#">Unspecified Bit Rate</a> with <a href="#">Peak Cell Rate</a> .
CBR	Use <a href="#">Constant Bit Rate</a> .
Non-Realtime VBR	Use Non-Real-Time <a href="#">Variable Bit Rate</a> .
Realtime VBR	Use Real-Time <a href="#">Variable Bit Rate</a> .
